### **Enrollment Process**

- The enrollment process must be completed in its entirety once **you start it**. If you close the process and start it again at another time, you will have to start from the beginning.
- The first-year student must enroll in **all the** subjects of the first year. In the case of having applied for recognition, the student must enroll in all subjects and when the dean's office delivers the official validation report, the enrollment will be adjusted at the Student Secretary's Office.
- If you are enrolled in a simultaneous degree or degrees where languages are taught, you must choose **two of the three** languages offered, which you will maintain throughout your degree (English, French and German).
