

Getting around by subway and bus


Apply for a transport card

People who do not yet have the Public Transport Card can apply for it **online** (they will receive it at home within 7 to 15 working days after placing the order) or in person at the **Public Transport Card** Management Offices (by appointment via 012 or at tarjetatransportepublico.crtm.es).

You can subscribe to the 30-day youth pass, which allows you to travel from zone A to E2, covering the entire Community of Madrid. The pass can be recharged directly at the automatic machines within the Metro network.

This same card also grants free entry to certain museums in Madrid and provides discounts on cultural activities.





The **30-day abono joven** allows you to move freely in all these zones, and you can also travel to the Community of Castilla La Mancha with the El and E2 zones.



Getting around by bicycle



Enjoy the city in a healthy and ecological way. The bicycle allows you to see the city at your own pace while exercising and enjoying the outdoors.

If you want to cycle every day, you can purchase an **annual pass** through **the BiciMAD application**, associating a means of payment to the **MPass** single account system. In addition, the annual pass can also be purchased **by directly associating the public transport card** to MPass.

Once the annual subscription is purchased, the user receives an e-mail or mobile message with a subscriber code.

Occasional use of the service is contracted through the application.

The annual subscription card is **personal and non-transferable**, and may not be assigned to third parties.

Travel with Renfe

Renfe is the leading railway operator in Spain.

If you want to **travel around Spain** during your stay in Madrid, we recommend that you subscribe to one of **Rende's student passes**:

The Renfe Youth Card + allows you to benefit from significant discounts on the purchase of your tickets to travel on AVE, Larga Distancia, Avant, Media Distancia and Cercanias/Rodalies trains.

Medical assistance for Spanish students

Spanish Social Security

To obtain the health card, it is necessary to be registered and affiliated to the Social Security:

You should go to the **Health Center** closest to your home to request a family doctor.

There you will have to fill in the corresponding form and submit it::

- Copy and original of the Social Security affiliation card.
- **Certificate of census registration** (It must be original and when requesting it you must indicate the reason for which you are requesting it, so that it appears in the certificate itself).
- An official identity document (passport, residence card, student card, etc.)

Medical assistance for EU students

European Health. Insurance card

If you are a **resident of a European Union country**, you must apply for a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) to have medical care covered during your stay.

The application is made at the health insurance organization where you are insured, prior to your arrival in Spain. You will receive your European Health Insurance Card within two to three weeks of your application.

The European Health Insurance Card guarantees you medical coverage for up to three months.

The TSE has the following limitations:

- It is not an alternative to travel insurance.
- It does not cover private health care or expenses such as the return flight to the country of origin.
- It does noy guarantee free medical services.





Medical assistance for non-EU students

Taking out private health insurance

If you reside in a **non-EU country**, you must take out **private health insurance** to obtain your student visa.

Perhaps your country has a health agreement with Spain: in this case you will have access to health care as a Spanish citizen would, but in any case it will only cover basic health care and only emergency expenses.

Accommodations

Find accommodation in Madrid

We guide you on the different types of housing, neighborhoods, prices, search engines, accommodation companies, etc. so that you can manage your stay more easily.

Before comparing the different options, it may be useful to know the average price of accommodation in Madrid:

APARTMENT (one bedroom)

from 600 to 1,200 €/month

SHARED APARTMENT

from 350 to 600 €/month

STUDENT HOUSING

from 800 to 1,300 €/month
